Learning outcomes	At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to: The aim of this seminar is to teach the student mastery of the basic techniques of university work: - understanding the notions of analysis, synthesis, summary, theory and empirical understanding, - research into and use of bibliographical sources, compiling notes from reading, using reference convention, - learning editing standards, and in particular the rules relating to plagiarism. This learning process also focuses on dealing with the problems involved in practical research.
Evaluation methods	For the seminar: continuous evaluation (written exam in October and written exam in session). For the practical work: personal work. Attendance at practical sessions is required. In accordance with article 72 of the General Regulations for Studies and Examinations, the Professors may propose to the jury that a student who has at least two unjustified absences for the practical sessions, be refused registration for the January, June or September session.
Content	First part of seminar involves lessons "ex-cathedra" (reviews and definition of scientific concepts, criticizes sources,). The seminar methodology involves also - active participation and group work by students some compulsory reading.
