Learning outcomes	<p>At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to :</p> <p>The minimum level of Dutch to be reached at the end of the year is B1+ as defined by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.</p> <p>The courses and the work to be done at home by the student are an integral part of the mastery of the language in terms of lexicon and grammatical structures. In addition, they prepare students for the second year specialised language course.</p> <p>At the end of the course, the student should be able to grasp the general meaning of authentic texts and make a structured synthesis of them, while being able to explain passages dealing with important data.</p> <p>A dispensatory exam will be organised remotely via the ELAO platform in September; students who obtain a sufficiently high mark in the written test will then be required to take an oral exam in person.
