



Teaching methods	<p>The Teaching Unit consists of classroom activities as well as a-learning activities.</p> <p>The more general vocabulary and the field-related vocabulary will be presented in written as well as audio texts used to exercise the reading and listening comprehension techniques .</p> <p>The vocabulary and the typical structures of the Dutch language will be revised, extended and tested by means of self-tuition in a Reading Portfolio and on the Moodle e-learning Platform. Some techniques of communication will be exercised by means of written and oral production exercise (role plays, presentations).</p>
