<p>Teaching methods</p>	<p>ANGL1191 – Q1 (15h)                  ANGL1191 – Q2 (15h)                  *Interactive course: communicative and interactive approach.                  One hour of English class per week: the attendance is highly recommended!- complemented with an optional grammar tutorial of one hour per week.                  The classroom hours (interactive) are essentially dedicated to speaking, writing and listening, focused on everyday situations (useful English) and the workplace.                  The grammar tutorial is strongly recommended to all students facing difficulties with basic grammar (and in need of explanations and additional grammar exercises guided by a teacher). A test is organised during the first class of terms 1 and 2 which allows the students to know their level.                  Students who are strong in English can be exempted from the English course after passing an exemption test (facultative!) with at least 16/20. The exemption test will be organized online in September. This test will confirm (or not) the student's level in English and will allow the student to be exempted (or not). Students who obtain a sufficiently high score (corresponding to 16/20 and +) can be exempted from the English course. The test is organized only once, at the start of the academic year. Details on how to register for the exemption test will be published on the university website.</p>
