Content	<p>Since the course focuses on developing the ability to understand authentic texts, news reports and film clips, the content is drawn from the Dutch-speaking Belgian media and deals with general topics as well as issues relating to the economic, social, political and cultural organization of society. The student will therefore be required to develop all four skills (reading and listening comprehension; written and oral expression). The student will also read <i>Freakonomics</i> (Steven D. Levitt et Stephen J. Dubner, De Bezige Bij, 2009) in Dutch. All this material is also used as a basis for lexical extension, grammar revision, synthesis and conversation exercises in Dutch.</p>
