


	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As far as speaking skills are concerned, the course focuses more on communicative skills than on correction. • For all the skills aforementioned: introduction to German culture.
Evaluation methods	<p>Several marks come into account for the final assessment :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • continuous assessment 50% (written and oral tests, instructions and plan in course notes) • examen at week 13, 50% . Written test 25% (listening 5%, grammar 5%, vocabulary 10% and writing 5%) and oral examen (25%). • the mark for the continuous assessment will not be considered in the september session. September exam: written examen (listening 10%, grammar 10%, vocabulary 20% and writing 10%) and oral examen (50%).
Teaching methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Groups of 25 students maximum. • Course hours : 30 hours in class • Self-study : 42 hours.
Content	<p>The activities are based on authentic documents (reading and listening comprehension). Basic vocabulary and structures are trained, reinforced and expanded via written and oral exercises (role-plays, interviews, conversations in small groups of 2 or 4, ').</p>
