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## The programme's courses and learning outcomes

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For each UCLouvain training programme, a [reference framework of learning outcomes](#) specifies the the skills expected of every graduate on completion of the programme. ## Teaching method

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Most courses offered within the Advanced Master in International Law are based on interactive teaching methods. In some of them, students are called upon to read materials beforehand, which enables them to engage with the selected topics and discuss them during the courses.

As the number of students is limited, they have access to a personalized supervision by professors, particularly on the occasion of the preparation of their Master's essay. The latter's subject-matter is determined by each student, in cooperation with one of the professors of the programme.

## Evaluation

More detailed explanation of the modalities specific to each learning unit are available on their description sheets under the heading "Learning outcomes evaluation method".**

The final assessment is continuously assessed ; there is also an assessment of the written overview and the dissertation. Apart from this, assessment is through written or oral examinations.

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The nature of the programme makes it attractive to foreign students; a large majority of students from foreign universities usually attend.
