Learning outcomes

This programme in the Advanced 2nd cycle is designed to prepare doctors to qualify for the professional status of specialist doctor in emergency medicine (Ministerial Decree of 14 February 2005, published on 4 March 2005).

Programme structure

Full-time training is at least 6 years and includes academic instruction, full-time work placements, communication or the publication of an article and a dissertation.

Prior training for the Advanced Master in Intensive Medicine may count towards this, for three years.

The plan for the placement drawn up by the university placement coordinator must be approved by the ministerial qualification committee for the relevant specialization. These placements include duty activities.

General access requirements

Art. 112. of the "Décret définissant le paysage de l'enseignement supérieur et l'organisation académique des études" :

- § 1. In accordance with the general requirements established by the academic authorities, students who have:
- 1. a master's degree;
- 2. an academic degree similar to the one mentioned in the preceding paragraph awarded by a higher education institution in the Flemish Community or the German-speaking Community, or by the Royal Military Academy, by virtue of a decision of the academic authorities and in accordance with any additional requirements they may establish;
- 3. a foreign academic degree recognised as equivalent to those mentioned in paragraphs 1 and 2 pursuant to this decree, a European directive, an international convention or other legislation, in accordance with the same requirements.

Specific professional rules

These studies lead to a professional title subject to specific rules or restrictions on professional accreditation or establishment.

Evaluation

The evaluation methods comply with the <u>regulations concerning studies and exams</u> (https://uclouvain.be/fr/decouvrir/ rgee.html). More detailed explanation of the modalities specific to each learning unit are available on their description sheets under the heading "Learning outcomes evaluation method".

Candidates' knowledge will be tested through continuous assessment by the placement supervisor and by examinations on the subjects taught. In addition, candidates must produce a piece of scientific work to present in a public class and to a national or international emergency medicine convention and/or published in a recognized scientific journal. A written and oral evaluation by an inter-university francophone jury takes place at the end of the 5th year.

When the above requirements have been fulfilled, the programme committee will award the academic qualification in emergency medicine.

This is not a substitute for recognition by the ministerial committee. It is evidence of academic and scientific training in the context of specialized training leading to the award of professional status.

Training as a specialist doctor in intensive medicine may count for three years towards the total of six years' training required to become a specialist doctor in emergency medicine.
