There is a variety of evaluation methods:

- completion of individual and/or group work;
- taking written or oral examinations to test the level of understanding and command of concepts, theories, basic data and know-how in the various disciplines concerned;
- completing a three-month work placement;
- completion of a thesis.

To obtain a grade average, the scores obtained for the different activities are weighted by their respective credits.
