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Teaching method

This programme, specifically designed for working people, combines theoretical lectures and case studies to give a concrete understanding of problems related to public administration.

The programme attracts students from a wide variety of professional and educational backgrounds. Differences of practice and varying points of view between students and instructors and among the students themselves enhance the students' perspective in regard to the different fields related to the programme.

By means of a variety of individual and group projects, the students are invited to adopt an analytical approach to their professional practice.

Evaluation

The evaluation methods comply with the [regulations concerning studies and exams](#). More detailed explanation of the modalities specific to each learning unit are available on their description sheets under the heading "Learning outcomes evaluation method".

There is a variety of evaluation methods: producing individual and/or group work, written or oral examinations and completing a thesis. To obtain a grade average, the scores obtained for the different activities are weighted by their respective credits.
