The program is available exclusively in English. Candidates will have to provide the following:

- either evidence of sufficient competence in English (level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference)
- or a transcript of university grades showing that they have taken and successfully completed at least 3 courses in English during their previous university studies.

The Master's admission jury has exclusive competence to determine whether, based on the available evidence, the applicant demonstrates a C1 level of proficiency.

Specific access requirements

Access may be restricted due to the limited number of available internship positions in the second year of the Master.
