- A strong interdisciplinary focus. This programme provides students with a critical understanding of European policies and governance through strongly integrated interdisciplinary modules.

- Describe and explain the EU's economic, political, legal and historical foundations and governing principles
 - Develop a critical and expert opinion on key challenges facing the EU (climate change, artificial intelligence, migration, threats to the rule of law, etc.)
 - Understand, analyse and evaluate major EU policies (trade, environment, defence and security, migration, etc.)
 - Write policy papers and develop advocacy/lobbying strategies
 - Apply for and manage EU funding
 - Boast a first job (internship) experience
