## Programme structure

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The student constructs his programme to include four main coherent sections: core courses, a dissertation (and supporting seminars), a focus (30 credits) and 25 ects of optional courses.

The programme of the first year of the Master is made up of:

- courses and a tutorial from the core courses ;
- the supporting seminars for the thesis ;
- optional courses for 15 credits (2nd semester).

The programme of the 2nd year of the Master is made up of:

- a lesson of Law, change and society.
- a tutorial in the selected focus.
- a selected focus, from the eight focuses available (on selection) either at UCLouvain, at KUL or abroad (1st semester) ;
- the thesis (spread out across the year) ;
- 10 ects of optional course, from the optional courses available or optional courses taken abroad at a partner university (Erasmus) (2nd semester).

## Detailed programme by subject






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#### o Echange - Droit économique (30 credits)

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**OPTIONS [25.0]**

In the first year, the student is required to choose 15 credits from the same option. All options are annual and are taught during the second term.

In the second year, the student chooses 10 elective course credits (either two UEs of the same option, or one option UE and one UE of their purpose or another, or two UEs of their purpose, or one UE of its purpose and one UE of another purpose (from a predefined list)).

The student going on an exchange trip replaces his choice of teaching units for the second quadrimester of the second year with teaching units of his choice in his host university, up to a maximum of 15 credits and subject to the agreement of the Faculty.

### Prerequisites and student's annual programme

As the prerequisite is for CU registration purposes only, there are no prerequisites within a programme year. Prerequisites are defined between CUs of different years and therefore influence the order in which the student will be able to register for the programme's CUs.

In addition, when the jury validates a student's individual programme at the beginning of the year, it ensures its coherence, meaning that it may:

- require the student to combine registration in two separate CUs which it considers necessary from a pedagogical point of view.
- transform a prerequisite into a corequisite if the student is in the final year of a degree course.

## Teaching method

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- Classing of course in focuses in options: coherence of subjects and constitution of teaching teams (especially for the options) ;
