Learning outcomes

The Master in Population Sciences and Development is an interdisciplinary program which studies the relationship between population and development. It includes related disciplines such as anthropology, demography, economics, political science, sociology and history. It prepares students for a professional career in the fields of demography and development and for research on both developed and developing countries.

Thanks to the wide range of focuses (two professional and one research) and options (seven in all), students can choose between different fields and gain specialization both in the subject (demography or development) or the geographical area (the main regions of the world) as well as in the methods (qualitative or quantitative) and professional objectives (action or research). Students will acquire

PROFESSIONAL FOCUS : DEVELOPMENT [30.0]

Cette finalité, axée sur les études du développement, a pour objectif d'offrir une formation spécialisée sur les problèmes de développement, en particulier ceux des sociétés non-occidentales. Elle ouvre, notamment, au travail dans la recherche ou dans des institutions diverses (ONG, institutions internationales,...). Elle vise la capacité à analyser une problématique de développement sur une base interdisciplinaire et comparative. Elle conjugue l'analyse des réalités locales et leurs interactions avec les dynamiques globales. Le programme, qui aborde les différentes problématiques liées au développement (genre, migration, économie populaire, ressources naturelles, environnement,...), permet aux étudiants d'intégrer théorie, recherche et action. La formation se poursuit par un choix entre deux options : Analyse du développement par aires géographiques, et Projets et programmes.

In addition, when the jury validates a student's individual programme at the beginning of the year, it ensures its coherence, meaning that it may:

- require the student to combine registration in two separate CUs which it considers necessary from a pedagogical point of view.
- transform a prerequisite into a corequisite if the student is in the final year of a degree course.

Access based on application : access may be granted either directly or on the condition of completing additional courses of a maximum of 60 ECTS credits, or refused.

Entry to all Masters (with the exception of Advanced Masters) can also be gained on submission of a special personal file.

Admission and Enrolment Procedures for general registration

Teaching method

The Master in Population Sciences and Development is an interdisciplinary program in the true sense of the term, through its main objective (bringing together the two fields of demography and development), through the teaching staff and the teaching material (from different disciplines) and also through the students (the Master is open to any university bachelor). All of this makes the teaching methods open and dynamic. Students are encouraged to work both individually and in groups, using the most effective communication and information tools. They may also participate in an internship in an organization, and enterprise or in a research team.
